

Job Description

Youth Pastor

Pastoral Duties

- Set aside time to wait on God, to hear his heartbeat for my life, the church and the community of the Fylde Coast.
- Communicate the 'Word of God' (the bible) in a relevant way to the various age groups.
- Pastor the 11-18 year olds and also people who don't belong to the church.
- Set up links with the various primary schools, lesson support, lead lessons, and assemblies and after school clubs.
- Do pastoral calling on the congregation and also people who don't belong to the church when appropriate and time permits.
- Reach out with the love of God and the truth of his word to men, women, boys and girls across the Fylde Coast and beyond.
- Discover, develop and deploy the giftedness of each individual enabling them to live life to the full.
- Outreach into local community via detached work (street evangelism)
- Organise and facilitate the weekly youth club.
- Attend weekly mentoring meeting with the senior leader.

Administrative Duties

- Lead meetings and opportunity to preach .
- Develop the Youth Team.
- Take part in weddings and funerals as requested and available.
- Take part in Dedications and Water Baptisms.
- Manage the financial affairs of the Youth ministry.
- Work with the trustees to assist them in carrying out their assigned tasks.

- Perform other administrative duties when requested
- Represent the Church dealing with outside organisations.
- Represent the church at area church events (i.e. association, training days and annual conference meetings).
- Organise annual Youth conference
- Liaise with Area director of AOG and attend all area meetings and training days, also annual conference.
- Develop relationships with other church leaders of the same and different denominations.

The successful applicant would be expected to work 2 days per week for the church (Sundays would be expected to be on a voluntary basis) and would be expected to find employment for the rest of the week. Accommodation will be provided.
