

MORE DETAILS

We are a small and friendly Pentecostal Church in the North West who are looking for a person to head the church and grow it both spiritually and numerically.

Westhoughton Pentecostal church is part of the Bolton borough and is only 20 minutes away by car and train from the centre of Manchester. The centre of Westhoughton is three minutes from junction 5 of the M61. Westhoughton was a town of 40,000 but there is new development going up all the time. For many, Westhoughton is considered to be a Manchester commuter town.

The church has a membership of 40 and a congregation in the morning of 60 and evening of around 20. There are a few children in the Sunday school. We also have a "Treasures" meeting for 7-11 year olds on a Wednesday evening with about 15 children and a coffee morning that runs in term time. We also have a monthly outreach to a Senior Citizens residence. We at present have House group once a fortnight and a Bible study and Prayer meeting once a fortnight.

The church is run by Elders and deacons who make up the Business Meeting.

The salary will be between £21,000 and £28,000 (plus mileage allowance) according to experience and holidays will be 25 days plus Bank Holidays (with a maximum of 6 Sundays). The church has no manse.
