## **Job Description:** **Senior Pastor of Greenbank Community Church**

### **The current Vision Statement of Greenbank Community Church:**

### **Principal Role:**

The Pastor is responsible for providing spiritual and pastoral leadership to the church congregation, church staff and those to whom care is provided within the community.

### **Accountable to:**

The Senior Pastor will be accountable and work alongside the Director, the present Eldership and Church Council.

### **Qualifications:**

- To be an accredited AOG minister accountable to both the local church leadership and the Assemblies of God area and national leadership, or working towards this
- To have experience in positions of church eldership and leadership

### **Desired attributes for a Senior Pastor of Greenbank Community Church:**

- Strong, compassionate and servant-hearted leadership
- The gift of teaching and preaching
- A natural ability and passion to pastor the church



- Demonstrates a life which is spiritually fruitful and gifted

## **Responsibilities**

- To serve as the spiritual leader who oversees the spiritual growth of the church congregation, staff and wider community; through this, equipping and releasing Christians for works of service as per the church's vision
- To be exemplary in leading the congregation to a place of Godly, spiritual worship and to create an environment that allows the congregation to draw closer to God
- To be a visionary; seeking God alongside the leadership team, in order to maintain or develop the vision, effectively convey and lead the congregation towards it. Furthermore, ensuring other leaders remain accountable and supportive to the pastor and the vision of the church
- To plan and organise eldership meetings where wisdom and strategy can combine for the fulfilment of the vision
- To promote and encourage the active prayer life of the church
- To proclaim the Gospel; leading and encouraging the church to proclaim the Gospel in the wider community
- As senior teacher within the church, encourage the congregation towards greater levels of discipleship
- To prayerfully consider and encourage the releasing of others in gifting
- To oversee the delegation of Sunday Service leadership, ensuring the maintenance of good order in accordance with biblical principles
- Conduct funeral services, wedding services, baptisms and dedications
- To attend AOG regional and national conferences including refresher training

## **Shared responsibilities with the eldership and leadership teams:**

- To be responsible for selecting visiting speakers who will bring teaching, prophetic or apostolic gifting into the church
- To provide a stable pastoral ministry which edifies, unites and promotes the maturity of the church
- To discipline and/or bring correction to members of the church where required
- To work with and encourage unity amongst other church leaders within the community of Liskeard
